ELIGIBILITY

These scholarships are intended for students who received a Durango High Noon Rotary Scholarship for their freshman year of an academic, vocational, or technical degree and who wish to apply for a continuing scholarship for subsequent years of schooling. Children of Rotary members are not eligible for these scholarships.

Applicants for a continuing scholarship should have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5. At its discretion, the Scholarship Committee may consider otherwise highly qualified applicants who have shown marked improvement in their GPA.

All Scholarship packages must be **complete** and be received by the **March 31, 2024** deadline to be eligible for consideration. **No late applications will be accepted, and no incomplete packages will be considered. NOTES:

1. BE SURE THAT THE STUDENT AID REPORT PORTION OF THE FAFSA DOCUMENT CLEARLY SHOWS YOUR STUDENT AID INDEX NUMBER. IF OTHER PORTIONS OF THE DOCUMENT STILL SAY 'TRANSFERRED FROM IRS' YOU MIGHT NOT HAVE A CLEAR SAI.
2. THE APPLICATION (pdf 1) and ATTACHMENTS (pdf 2) SHOULD BE SENT AS TWO SEPARATE FILES, WITH ATTACHMENTS ORGANIZED IN THE SAME ORDER AS THE CHECKLIST ABOVE
