

2024 APPLICATION FOR DURANGO HIGH NOON ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Durango High Noon Rotary Club is awarding multiple scholarships totaling approximately \$30,000. Scholarships will be awarded in amounts from \$1,000 to \$3,000 depending on demonstration of need and merit. Scholarships will be available to the following:

- Applicants pursuing a four-year academic degree at a post-secondary college or university
- 2. Applicants pursuing an associate or vocational/technical degree
- 3. Applicants pursuing a paramedic degree/certification.

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are available to high school seniors graduating from any La Plata County high school or the Mancos High School, as well as residents of the Four Corners Area with a high school diploma or GED interested in pursuing higher education. Children of Rotary members are not eligible for these scholarships.

An applicant for an academic scholarship should have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or above. At its discretion, the Scholarship Committee may consider otherwise highly qualified applicants who have shown marked improvement in their GPA during their Junior and Senior years regardless of their GPA. To maintain eligibility for renewal in subsequent years applicants must maintain a 2.5 or higher GPA.

All Scholarship packages must be **complete** and be **received** by the **March 31**, **2024** deadline to be eligible for consideration. **No late applications will be accepted. Instructions for compiling and submitting your application and supporting documents is listed on the Application Checklist (page 2 of this document)**
