Native Hope Ministries - Our Mission

- We target individuals and families, typically elders or single parents with children, with the greatest needs-often no electricity, running water, or transportation; isolation; homes in poor condition; and no source of income.
- We help other families who need short term assistance to get back on their feet.
- Together with our employees we deliver food, clean water and firewood, as well as make home repairs and install solar lighting units.

Native Hope Ministries - Solar and Home Repairs

- We make homes more livable with repairs and installation of solar lighting units.
- We use both employee help and volunteers.
- Home Repair request are evaluated by our board and projects are selected based on need and scope of work.
- Teams are formed 4 months before the project.
- Most projects are complete within a week.

Native Hope Ministries - Firewood

- Our Navajo employees transport firewood from Durango to the reservation.
- It is most commonly in the form of rounds which are split and delivered to families who rely on wood for heating and cooking.

- Our Native Hope truck, with trailer and water tank, makes regular rounds to bring fresh water to families.
- We hand out 55 gallon drums and pumps as needed.

Native Hope Ministries - Family to Family

- Our Family to Family program matches Navajo families with Durango-area families.
- About 35, mostly local, families send boxes of food and household supplies each month to “their family.”
- Each Navajo family agrees to do a kindness for someone outside their household.
- All families agree to communicate back and forth where possible as a way to grow cultural understanding.
