

2025 APPLICATION FOR DURANGO HIGH NOON ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Durango High Noon Rotary Club is awarding multiple scholarships totaling approximately \$30,000. Scholarships will be awarded in amounts from \$1,000 to \$3,000 depending on demonstration of need and merit. Scholarships will be available to the following:

- 1. Applicants pursuing a four-year academic degree at a post-secondary college or university.
- 2. Applicants pursuing an associate or vocational/technical degree.
- 3. Applicants pursuing a **paramedic degree/certification**.

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are available to any graduating senior, aspiring higher education student with GED or High School Diploma, or ongoing post-secondary education student in any year. Any student in the Four Corners is eligible. Students of current Rotary members are not eligible for these scholarships.

An applicant for an academic scholarship should have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or above. At its discretion, the Scholarship Committee may consider otherwise highly qualified applicants who have shown marked improvement in their GPA during their Junior and Senior years regardless of their GPA. To maintain eligibility for renewal in subsequent years, applicants must maintain a 2.5 or higher GPA.

All Scholarship packages must be **complete** and be received by the March 31, 2025 deadline to be eligible for consideration. No late applications will be accepted. Instructions for compiling and submitting your application and supporting documents are listed on the Application Checklist (page 2 of this document).

- 1. BE SURE THAT THE STUDENT AID REPORT PORTION OF THE FAFSA DOCUMENT CLEARLY SHOWS YOUR Student Aid Index (SAI) NUMBER. IF OTHER PORTIONS OF THE DOCUMENT STILL SAY 'TRANSFERRED FROM IRS', YOU MIGHT NOT HAVE A CLEAR SAI.
- 2. THE APPLICATION (pdf 1) and ATTACHMENTS (pdf 2) SHOULD BE SENT AS TWO SEPARATE FILES, WITH ATTACHMENTS ORGANIZED IN THE SAME ORDER AS THE CHECKLIST ABOVE.
